JAN VAN NOORD (no photo available) owns and lives at Portofino Beach Resort, and has been instrumental in starting a neighborhood watch further north called Middle Island Neighborhood Watch. He came here from Belgium the 1st time in October 2000 and moved here January 2001. He has Dutch Nationality and now also Belizean. When asked what on the island should never be changed he said "Everything". To the question what need changed now he said "Nothing".



JUAN GUERRA came here from Mango Creek five years ago and is a carpenter at Portofino's. Jan Van Noord paid for him to work on the NACNW police station. "What never needs to change is the reef and mangroves." What needs changed is to "Stop the fishing. We need to save the fish."



HECTOR HERNANDEZ is a maintenance worker at Capricorn who sent him for the day to work on the NACNW police substation. He has been here for eight years and lives on North Ambergris Caye. "We must save the reef and the trees. There are a lot of things that need changed but the first one is the north road."


Mayan Ruin Weddings, a completely unique, fascinating option that is also
