Good Things To Know About San Pedro Town & Belize

Belize has been an independent nation since 1981, it is a member of the British Commonwealth of Nations.

O Ambergris Caye

Ambergris Caye is twenty-five miles long; its width ranges from a few hundred feet to over four miles. Northern Ambergris Cave is separated from the southernmost tip of Mexico's Yucatan Peninsula by a small channel. After arriving in Belize City, a short fifteen minute airplane ride gets you to San Pedro, or if you would rather take the scenic route. an hour's boat ride will get you there as well.

O Language

English is the official language and is widely spoken, as is Spanish. Other languages include Creole, Garifuna, Mayan and German. O Climate Belize weather is characterized by two seasons: a rainy and a dry

season. Most of the year's rainfall occurs during the period of June to November, that is, the rainy season. The average temperature varies from 81°F/27°C along the coast to 69°F/21°C in the hills. The coldest month is January while the highest temperatures are experienced during the month of May

O Cash & Currency

U.S. dollars are accepted as currency countrywide. The common exchange ratio is \$282/\$1 U.S. Licensed moneychangers offer a slightly higher exchange rate, ranging from \$2,058Z to \$2,128Z, depending on the current market

Nearly all hotels, restaurants and shops accept Visa, Master Card and travelers' checks. Street vendors and smaller establishments in remote areas may accept only cash or travelers' checks. O Sales Taxes

Belize's sales tax is set at 9% and it is applied to all goods and

services, except for telecommunications. There is a 7% hotel tax. Some hotels also add a 10-15% "service charge" to the bill: inquire about this when checking hotel prices. O Transportation

The streets are sand, which is great for walking or bike riding. There are few cars; instead, the vehicles of choice are electric colf carts, which are available for rent. Please remember that all golf cart drivers MUST have a valid drivers license. Drive with caution, there are many speed humos around the dountnum area that are not marked and always he on the lookout for potholes. Taxi service is available everyplace south of Boca del Rio. Around town the average fee is \$7BZ. Some local business, as well as resorts, rent bicycles.

O Telecommunications All telecommunications services (direct dial phones, fax, telex,

cable) are available. There are several "internet Cafe's" on the island where you can access the internet through high-speed internet or satellite connections

A thirty-minute boat ride from San Pedro Town takes you to a carefree, relaxed, unique travel destination. Cave Caulker, a four-mile long island located one mile west of the Belize Barrier Reef, re-

mains friendly and easy-going, a place where you can truly take your shoes off and relax...there is no rush...just go slow! This laid back village is primarily a fishing village and the way to get around is by golf carts, bicycles and bare feet. Shoes are a "nono," and the golf cart mode of transportation is unique The island is divided into two parts by the split

The main village is located in the southern portion of the island. Hurricane Hattie in 1961 divided the island at the split, a narrow waterway between the two islands. miles northeast of Belize City, Caye Caulker is e ily accessible by regularly scheduled water taxis. The Caye Caulker Water Taxi Association operates regular water taxi service out of Belize City. Water taxis depart seven times daily from Belize City's Marine Terminal on North Front Street, arriving 45 minutes later at the main pier. Currently the airstrip is being reconstructed and will soon be better equipped to handle air traffic. While reconstruction is taking place, the island is accessible only by boat. The airstrip is expected to reopen early next month, and Tropic Air and Maya Island Air will resume their regular flights to and from Caye Caulker. The flight is less than 10 minutes away from the Belize mainland, offering hourly commuter flights from the Phillip Goldson International Airport and the municipal airport in Belize City.

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Reef Brief

American Saltwater Crocodile world. They have an average length of 12 feet, but grow to be up to 23 feet long!

They can weigh between 500 to 1,000 nounds. These crocodiles live mostly in saltwater lagoons, swamps, and marshes because they prefer saltwater. However, they can be found in freshwater.





Mature crocodiles feed on small mammals, birds, crabs, and fish. Sn crocodiles eat insects, froms, snails, crabs, and small fish. They have also been known to feed on carcasses, baby crocodiles. If provoked, they may attack humans and have been known to eat dogs and cats. Crocodiles build their nests in the sand along shorelines. They lay from 20 to 60 eggs, which take about 90 days to hatch. The mothers protect their nests from intruders by rising up out of the water and attacking with a load roar. When the babies hatch, they make a loud squeaky call. The mother then pulls

apart the nest, gathers up her babies in her mouth, and carries them into the water. The babies stay with their mother for up to 20 weeks for protection from would-be predators like raccoons, coatimundis, herons, and male crocodiles. Crocodiles are an important part of our ecosystem and they are listed as Vulnerable to Extinction by the IUCN (the World Conservation Union). We all know to be careful in an area that is inhabited by crocodiles. Even dangerous animals have a place, so let's treat the American Saltwater Crocodile with respect

Belted Kingfishers teach their young to fish by dropping little fish into the wa-ter for retrieval. Training sessions can be dangerous. It's not unusual for the young to drown. The training period only lasts about three weeks before the parents force the fledeling to leave the natal

Ambergris must have a large population of Kingfishers. I see them almost everywhere I go, even when I am cruising the mangrove channels in the back of the island. I read that they nest in tunnels that are due into banks along streams. I wonder what adaptations Ambergris Kingfishers have had to make with our sandy soil and mangrove lagoons In my research of the Kingfishers, I
