

SP helps boy needing kidney

If there is ever a time in need, the time is now. Young Ryan Richards has been diagnosed with a deadly kidney disease and is pleading with the general public for some assistance in aiding him finan-

cially to pay for his operation. Doctors, friends and family are working tirelessly in collaborative efforts to reach the potential goal of raising the money. An estimated amount of \$30,000US is considered nec-

essary for the surgery.

Past records show that children who have died from this illness are either deprived of the finances necessary for the required medical attention or simply because of neglect. The "Friends of Pediatrics" is a non-governmental organization that provides tertiary healthcare to underprivileged children and is doing everything in their power to assist young Ryan Richards through his dilemma. Because kidney impairment is life threat-

No settlement over new taxes

On Friday, February 11th, the Government of Belize (GOB) and the Trade Union Congress (TUC) signed an 11-point agreement committing to work together to review the budget proposed by GOB. In the agreement, TUC set out to do two main things; the first being to review the recurrent expenditure

of the budget with the objective of reducing expenses and the second was to review the National Trade Union and Congress of Belize's proposals, submitted to GOB on January 31st, 2005.

Land sale angers SPTC





ening, disorders and diseases that may affect the kidney deserve prompt attention. Kidney diseases often show no symptoms until late in its course and can lead to end-stage kidney failure, which is fatal unless a dialysis machine is used or a kidney transplant is performed. Therefore, early help is vital during this process; Ryan is expected to receive 16-dialysis treatments before his operation. Accordingly, for every dialysis process he will need a whopping \$485US, adding up to a total of \$7,760US.

In an effort to raise funds, the family and everyone involved are hosting fund raising events and other activities to reach the estimated amount. Reef Radio hosted a radio-thon that raised approximately \$9,000BZ.
