plains safety protocol we are off, smoothly slicing through crystal clear waters. The weather is perfect and the day is off to a fine start.

As we cross the calm waters to the mainland Alexandra, who has a good knowledge of the area, points out areas of interest. She even spots a manatee as we venture across the bay - some of us are fortunate to see it before it eludes us. Pelicans soar above and cormorants skim the waters surface as we grow closer to the entrance of the Old Northern River. The boat slows down as we approach the river mouth and

we enter a narrow channel that is bordered with thick Mangrove growth. As we cruise the river Alexandra offers us traditional Belizean Johnny-cakes filled with chicken and refreshments and the food hits the spot while we enjoy the relaxing boat ride. We are on the look out for crocs in the water and are not disappointed when we spot a few along the way. 

where our boat journey ends.

Bomba is a riverside community that consists of modest wooden homes and does not have electricity. Many of the residents are skilled wood workers and they market their carved and polished works of art at little stands along the road. Their craft is impressive and it is the perfect opportunity to do a little gift shopping. The people are warm and friendly and happy to barter should you buy in quantity! After we browse and shop a bit it is time to board the van and head for Altun Ha. Mario, who has worked for Maruba for 20 years, is our driver and guide to the ruins. Along the

way he entertains us with stories of the area as he points out places and points of interest. The time passes quickly and it is not long before we have arrived at Altun Ha.



The tangled jungle surrounds the ruins and this palm tree has succumbed to the strangling embrace of a fig tree.

As we enter the grounds the area opens into a huge expanse of impressive temples and excavated structures. There are several school groups visiting the ruins and it is fun to see chil-

dren playing at the footsteps of their ancestors. Mario explains that the Maya began occupying the Altun Ha area in 1000 BC and the city was expanded in AD 700. At one point the

population reached its peak with an estimated population of 3,000. Although that population is fairly low compared to other Maya cities, the individuals

who resided in and around Altun Ha appear to have been considerably wealthy and powerful. This is evident from the amount of high status items, including jade that has been recovered at the site and the richly furnished tomb of one of Altun Ha's rulers. Among its contents the largest jadeite sculpture yet found representing '*Kinich Ahau*', the Maya sun god was found. The evidence recovered from Altun Ha indicates that this center participated in, and reaped the benefits from, a trade network – probably dominated by Tikal (Guatemala) that connected the Caribbean coast with the core of the central lowlands.

We spend an hour exploring the grounds and climbing the tallest temple, which offers an incredible view of the jungle top. Brilliant dragonfly's circle above us as Mario tells us fascinating stories of war, religion and human sacrifice. The area has a magic of its own and Mayan mystic seems to cast its spell over us as we wander the jungle that was once home to these amazing people. It is a grand adventure and we are a bit tired (and hungry) when we return to the van. We continue our journey to Maruba where we are looking forward to the special treat that lies before us deep inside the jungle.

hair treatments.

After pampering yourself and indulging in a delightful massage, grab a bite to eat at Maruba's restaurant. The two hardest decisions to make for the day include one – where to sit, whether to enjoy the first floor of the open palapa amidst the glorious landscaping, its second floor where the tops of trees are right at your fingertips and swooping birds peep in to say "hello" or the poolside deck where the sound of the pool's waterfall invites you to take a dip. 

even a paper cup if that's all you have.

It's like anything else, though – as your interest and experience levels increase, you tend to seek out some of the fun toys that improve on the experience.

But some glasses really do offer advantages. Glasses with bigger, tulipshaped bowls improve red wines by capturing and showing off the aromas. Whites are served cooler, which can tamp down aromas, and are fine in the smaller, narrower glasses with less of What about those bistro glasses? a tapered rim. Some people drink reds and whites out of the same big tulipshaped glasses.

#### How much should you pour?

Five ounces is considered a serving for both white and red wine. But people tend to fudge, particularly when they're pouring into enormous glasses; pouring six ounces into big glasses should be just fine.

Those work fine, particularly with pizza or something rustic and fun. But it is interesting to notice the way that a wine's aromas are captured in tulip-shaped glasses. You can try it yourself as an experiment: drink the same wine out of a bistro glass and then a tulip-shaped glass. You'll see how much more aroma, and therefore flavor, there is with wine served in the traditional tulip-shaped glasses.
