Fishing with Dilzon!!



Dilzon takes his time to dress up the "ballyhoo" which he used as bait. Its tantalizing pink lures brought us a 50 pound Dorado.

Sunny skies, soothing breezes and the deep Caribbean Sea was the perfect setting for an afternoon of big game fishing at its best. The Sun tagged along with fisherman extraordinaire Dilzon Murcia, to take on the big waves and go beyond the reef just a few miles offshore to catch a variety of big game species using light and big game tackle.

The experienced captain Dilzon and his first mate David help the vacationing fishing enthusiast bring in

any fish, even if they have little or no previous experience. Your adventure can be slated for either a full day or a half-day on his fishing boat. Once onboard "Dilzon Charters" you will be in pursuit of big game fish. Our boat ride up to our destination felt like riding rollercoaster with the sea's high waves kicking us up and down and from side to side - "Whoo,

what a thrill ride." With tackle, and fishing lines casted, the fishing escapade began.

In our Caribbean waters, fish are caught year-round and with an abundance of species to choose from including, Blue Marlin, White Marlin, Sailfish, Wahoo, Dorado, Tuna, Kingfish, Barracuda, Grouper and more. The fishing trip was amazing, and Captain Dilzon's ability to sniff out where they were kept us on fish all day.



fuzzy feeling calmed the soul and relaxed the mind, but that was not the end of the trip. Again, we saw the tug on the fishing rod and immediately started reeling in. Who would have thought that our luck would change: almost 15 minutes in and Dilzon was fighting with the catch of the day. Closer and closer it got, and we realized it wasn't a blackfin tuna but something much bigger. Could it be a shark, a barracuda or blue marlin playing mind games with us? At the end of the line it was a beautiful green and yellow fish, the name of which we didn't know at the time, until Dilzon told us what it was. A good sized mahi-mahi was at the end of the line; a beautiful fish locally known as "dorado" and wow what a beauty it was. The fish had green and gold flanks that light up with a rainbow of iridescent colors. We were awestruck by the sight of this big catch "dorado" which was a first for most on the boat. We felt like winners for having caught such a big fish, but the darkness of the night was setting in on

us so we reeled in our lines and started with our trip back home.

The fishing trip was fantastic, we enjoyed every last minute and promised Dilzon that we would return to do it again. Dilzon wasted no time in cleaning, cutting and distributing the tuna fillets to everyone on board. The hardest part was deciding how to cook it!

Government

Belize has been an independent nation since 1981. It is a member of the British Commonwealth of Nations.

Ambergris Caye

Ambergris Caye is twenty-five miles long; its width ranges from a few hundred feet to over four miles. Northern Ambergris Caye is separated from the southernmost tip of Mexico's Yucatan Peninsula by a small channel. After arriving in Belize City, a short fifteen minute airplane ride gets you to San Pedro, or if you would rather take the scenic route, an hour's boat ride will get you there as well.

C Language

English is the official language and is widely spoken, as is Spanish. Other languages include Creole, Garifuna, Mayan and German.

Climate

Belize weather is characterized by two seasons: a rainy and a dry season. Most of the year's rainfall occurs during the period of June to November, that is, the rainy season. The average temperature varies from 81°F/27°C along the coast to 69°F/21°C in the hills. The coldest month is January while the highest temperatures are experienced during the month of May.

Cash & Currency

U.S. dollars are accepted as currency countrywide. The common exchange ratio is \$2BZ/\$1 U.S. Licensed moneychangers offer a slightly higher exchange rate, ranging from \$2.05BZ to \$2.12BZ, depending on the current market.

Nearly all hotels, restaurants and shops accept Visa, Master Card and travelers' checks. Street vendors and smaller establishments in remote areas may accept only cash or travelers' checks.

Sales Taxes

Belize's sales tax is set at 10% and it is applied to all goods and services. Some hotels also add a 10-15% "service charge" to the bill; inquire about this when checking hotel prices.

Transportation

The streets are sand, which is great for walking or bike riding. There are few cars; instead, the vehicles of choice are electric golf carts, which are available for rent. Please remember that all golf cart drivers MUST have a valid drivers license. Drive with caution, there are many speed bumps around the downtown area that are not marked and always be on the lookout for potholes. Taxi service is available everyplace south of Boca del Rio. Around town the average fee is \$7 - \$10BZ. Some local business, as well as resorts, rent bicycles.

Telecommunications

All telecommunications services (direct dial phones, fax, telex, cable) are available. There are several "Internet Cafe's" on the island where you can access the internet through high-speed internet or satellite connections.





Ingredients

5lb. boneless chicken breasts Fajita Seasoning Black Pepper Season- All ½ Cup Vinegar

Sauce

3 cups BBQ Sauce ½ cup Steak Sauce 3 tbsp. Prepared Mustard

3 tbsp. Worcestershire Sauce



2 cups water 4 medium onions, sliced 3 Lrg. sweet pepper

2 tbsp. Soy Sauce

1/4 cup Marie Sharps

4 tbsp. Brown sugar

Sprinkle seasoning over boneless

breast. Slightly pound breast and add vinegar. Refrigerate over night. Mix sauce and set aside.

Brown the seasoned chicken breast in hot oil both sides. Place breast in heavy pot. Add the sauce. Turning breast occasionally, simmer until sauce is absorbed and onions are tender.

Chicken Wraps with Roasted Tomato and Goat Cheese



3 large tomatoes, sliced

2 tbsp. olive oil, divided

Salt and pepper 3/4 cup (about 5 1/3 oz.) goat cheese, softened 2 tbsp. minced parsley 2 boneless, skinless chicken breasts (about 3/4 lb.)

1½ cups shredded romaine lettuce4 flour tortillas (about

8" in diameter)

Heat oven to 300° F. Line sheet pan with

foil; place tomato slices in single layer. Drizzle with 1 tbsp olive oil and sprinkle with salt and pepper. Bake until slices have shriveled slightly, about 30 min.

In a small bowl combine goat cheese and parsley. Heat remaining 1 tbsp oil in medium nonstick skillet over medium high heat. Add chicken and sauté 8-10 min., turning once. Place chicken on cutting board and let rest 5 min; cut into very thin slices.

To assemble, heat each tortilla for 10 seconds in microwave to soften, then place in a clean work surface. Spread with cheese, then top with lettuce, tomato and chicken. Roll tortillas tightly; wrap in plastic wrap and chill. When ready to serve, remove from plastic; cut diagonally into 1" pieces. Serve with a soup if desired.






